Update on AP's Products and the Prescription Drug Data Collection Report

Dear Valued Producer,

With the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2021 (CAA) continuing to transform healthcare, AP Insurance & Benefit Solutions wanted to provide you with an update on the Prescription Drug Data Collection (RxDC) Report as it relates to our products.

Under RxDC, health issuers must submit detailed data on prescription drug pricing and healthcare spending. For the next report due June 1, 2023, most groups enrolled in medical through AP Connect will not have to take action. Below is a breakdown on the reporting process each carrier and program has adopted:

- Kaiser Permanente Industry Health Trusts: Reporting was provided to Kaiser; no group action needed.
- Kaiser Permanente Small Group: Each group was provided a link to a survey from Kaiser Permanente requesting employer and employee premium paid during 2022. Premium reporting data is always available through SIMON. If you have any questions, please contact Kaiser Permanente at nw.kp.ebs@kp.org or 866-246-3613.
- **Premera Blue Cross Industry Health Trusts:** Vimly to provide premium data to Premera; no group action needed. See Premera Producer News for more information.
- Regence BlueShield/Asuris Northwest Health Industry Health Trusts and Small Group: Carrier reporting on behalf of all fully insured group; no group action needed. See FAQ with more information on Regence.com.
